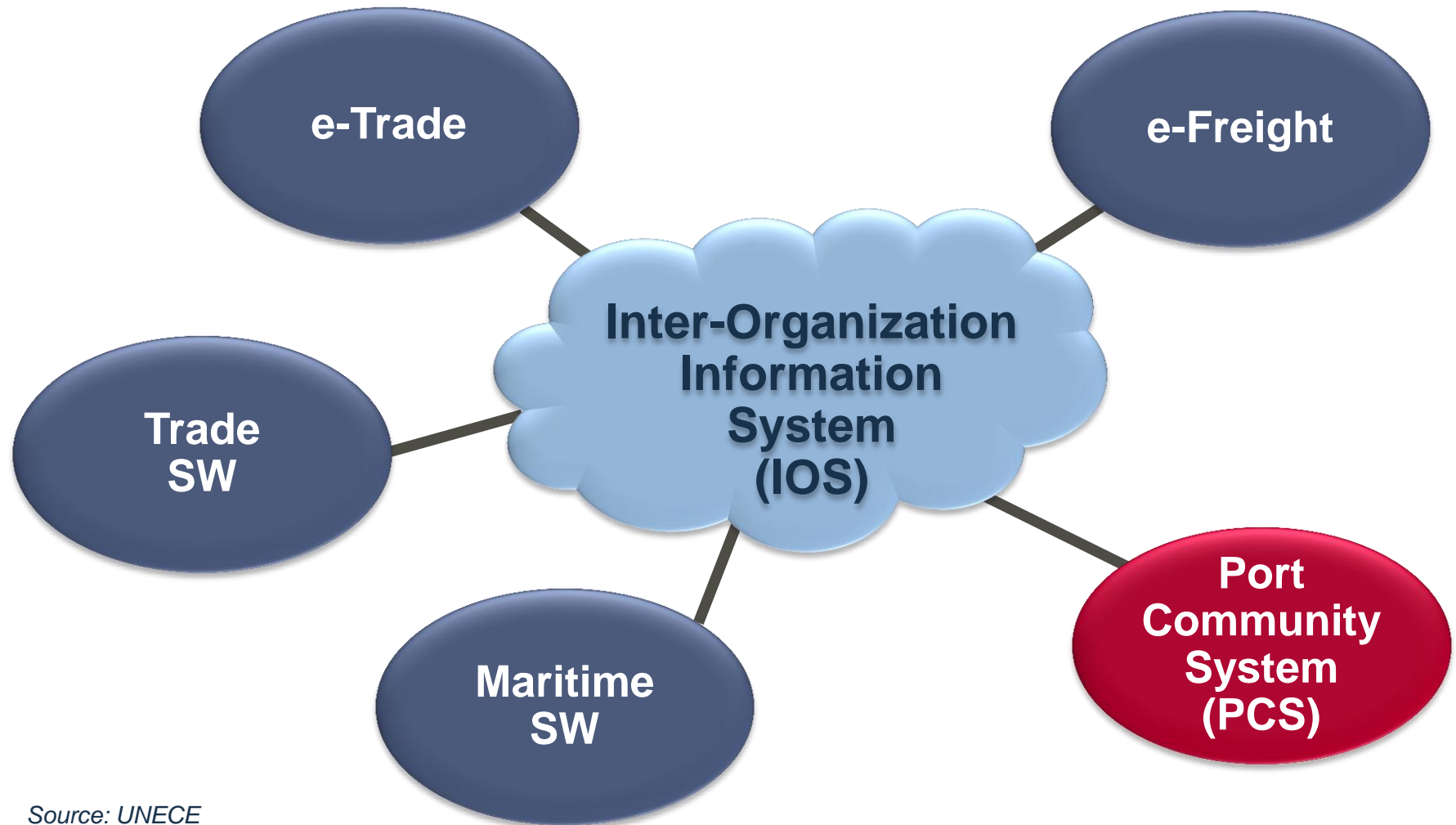

# What is a Port Community System?

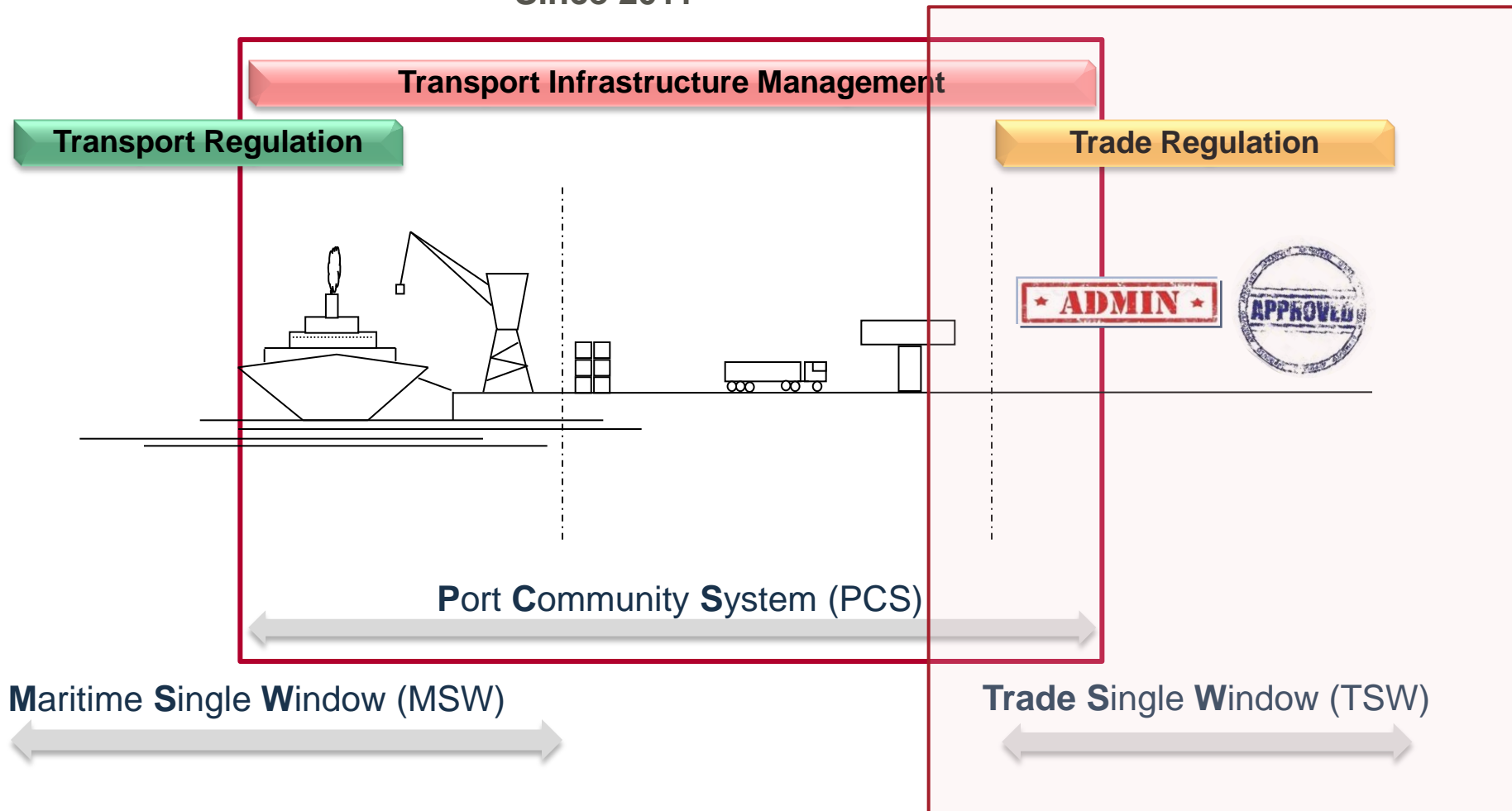
- ▶ An **information system** that automates aggregates, **optimizes and secures business processes** of public and private stakeholders in the port community.
- ▶ A **trade facilitation environment** for the **dematerialization and automation** of logistics and administrative **processes** in ports for import, export, transit and transshipment operations.



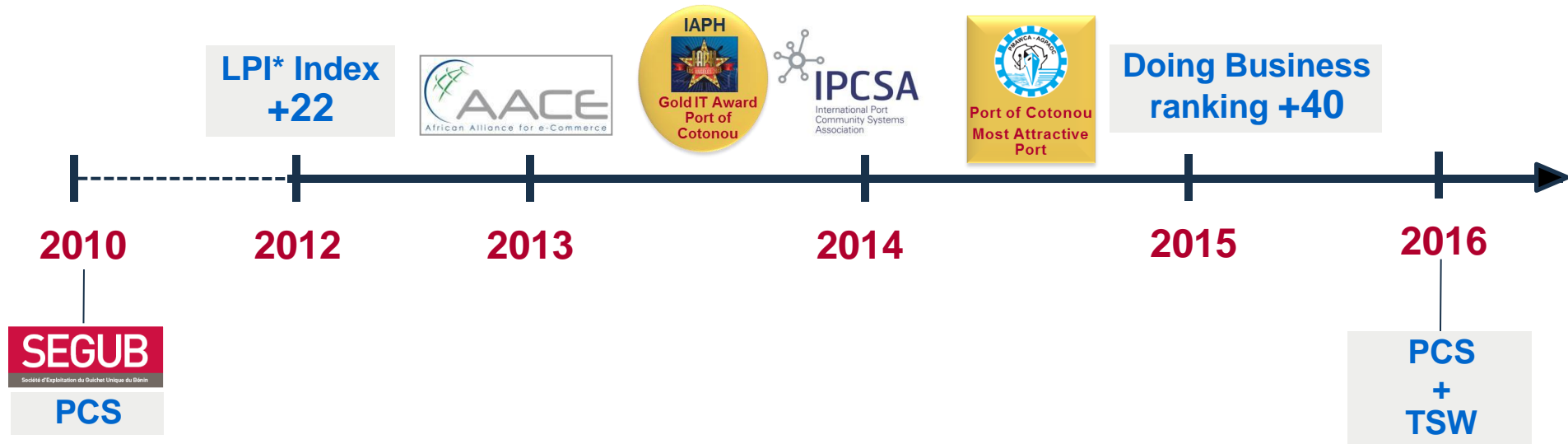

- ▶ Interoperability between Port Community System (PCS) and Trade Single Window.
- ▶ Interoperability with all Customs Management System (CMS). The Single Administrative Document (SAD) should be filled in the Trade Single Window (TSW), only, and shared with CMS for further Customs processes.
- ▶ ASYCUDA being in force in 41 countries in Africa, ensures that UNCTAD is properly involved in the projects.
